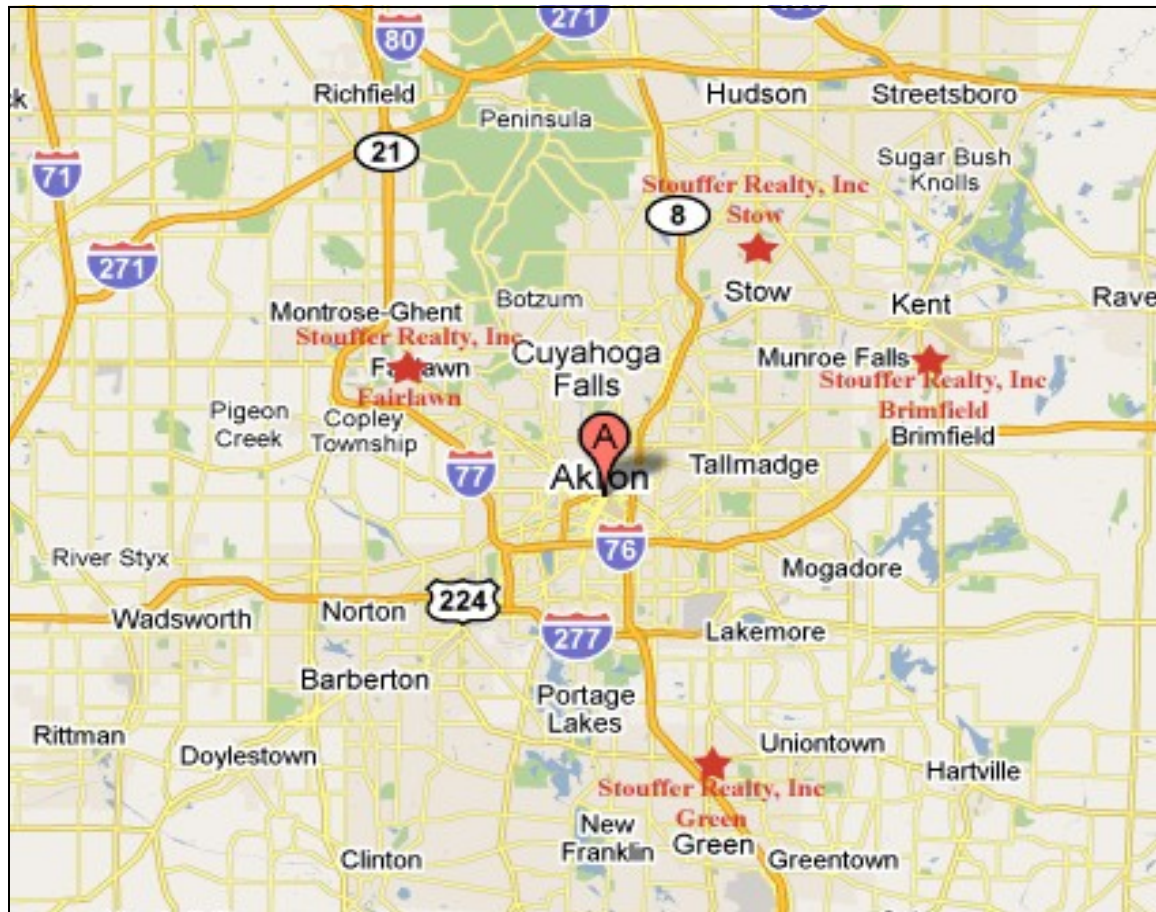

AKRON

Akron is the county seat of [Summit County](#). There are 217,074 people residing in the city. The city is home to the [Akron Aeros](#) Double A affiliate of the [Cleveland Indians](#), the [Soap Box Derby](#) World Championships and the [Firestone Country Club](#), at which the [PGA Tour's WGC-Bridgestone Invitational](#) is annually played. Akron is home to many [Fortune 500](#) companies including the [Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company](#) and [FirstEnergy](#). The [University of Akron](#) is home to over 23,000 students. The University also offers a combined B.S./M.D. program with the [Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine](#). The [Akron Public Schools](#) are currently going through an \$800 million rebuilding process that will take 15 years, remodeling some schools and entirely replacing others. [Archbishop Hoban High School](#) is the Catholic High School. [Stan Hywet Halls and Gardens](#) is a magnificent historic house museum and country estate. For performing arts, Akron offers [E.J. Thomas Hall](#), [Civic Theater](#), [Weathervane Playhouse](#), [Coach House Theater](#) and [John S. Knight Center](#). Akron also features the [Akron Art Museum](#), [Akron Zoo](#), [Lock 3 Park](#), and [the Akron Symphony Orchestra](#).

AURORA

Aurora is located in [Portage County](#), with a population of 14,548 people. Aurora is home to the [Geauga Lake Wildwater Kingdom](#). The [Aurora Farms Premium Outlet Stores](#) are a great place to shop with over 70 stores and restaurants. The [Aurora Community Theatre](#) is one of the best established community theatres in Northeast Ohio. Over 1,100 acres of parks and recreational property is used for [recreational needs, scouting programs and community gardens](#). [Thorn Creek Winery and Gardens](#) is home to Aurora's annual Wine Fest. The [Aurora City School District](#) includes all of Aurora and a portion of Reminderville. This growing metropolitan city offers a contemporary appeal while maintaining its historical small town charm.

BARBERTON

Barberton is located in [Summit County](#). 27,899 people reside there. The city features [parks with skating rinks, tennis courts, and both adult and youth sport leagues](#). The [Lake Anna YMCA Community Center](#) is a 57,000 sq. ft. facility with a [competition swimming pool](#), the Barberton Community Parks and Rec. Center, [Active Adults Division](#) and the [Anna Dean Physical Therapy and Performance Center](#), operated by [Summa Barberton Citizens Hospital](#). [The Magical Theater](#), in the Alexander Square historic district, is one of only six theaters in the U.S. dedicated to children and family productions. The [Lake Anna Gazebo summer concert series](#) offers concerts throughout the summer. Two of the city's most important assets are the [Ohio & Erie Canal](#) and [Anna Dean Farm](#). [Barberton City Schools](#) have been designated excellent by the State of Ohio.

BATH

Bath Township is a township of [Summit County](#), with 9,635 people residing in the township. Most of Bath Township is in the [Revere Local School District](#), with part of the township being in the [Copley-Fairlawn City School District](#). The portion that is in the Revere district is also in the [Cuyahoga Valley Career Center District](#). [Old Trail School](#), an independent co-ed day school, is situated in [Cuyahoga Valley National Park](#). In 1997 and 1998, a 404 acre former [Firestone](#) property was purchased by Bath Township and named [Bath Nature Preserve](#), which has, through an agreement, been used by the [University of Akron](#) as a research station. [Hale Farm and Village](#) is an outdoor living history museum featuring life and crafts from the mid-1800s.

BOSTON TOWNSHIP

Boston Township is a township of [Summit County](#). There are approximately 1,664 people in the township. Two villages are located in Boston Township; most of [Boston Heights](#), in the northeast, and [Peninsula](#), in the center. Schooling for most of the township is provided by [Woodridge Local School District](#); an eastern area is included in the [Hudson City School District](#).

BRIMFIELD

Brimfield City and Township is located in [Portage County](#). There are 3,248 people residing in Brimfield. The township is a rural area between [Akron](#) and [Kent](#) with light industry, shopping, subdivisions, and farms. [Field Local School System](#) which services Brimfield, states “they are making footprints worth following”. [Viking Vineyards](#) is Brimfield’s only winery. Both the [Brimfield Historical Society and Kelso House Museum](#) are rich with Brimfield’s history. The [Cascades of Brimfield](#) is the newest shopping and dining venue in the area. [Dussel Farms](#) offers a first-hand look at our farm's role in food production and soil conservation, hosting field trips that are both enjoyable and educational.

CANTON

Canton is the county seat of [Stark County](#), consisting of 80,806 people residing in the city. Canton is home to the [NFL Pro Football Hall of Fame](#), the [William McKinley Presidential Library/National Monument](#), and the [National First Ladies Library and Research Center](#). Copley is located in [Summit County](#), with a population of 13,641. Copley Township falls within the [Copley-Fairlawn City School District](#). Small portions of the township are located in the [Highland](#), [Revere](#) or [Akron School districts](#). All of these schools are highly regarded for their competent learning environment. [Copley Community Park](#) offers two large mulched playgrounds for kids. The playgrounds have swing sets, walking bridges, tunnels and more. Other amenities include open spaces, soccer fields, baseball fields, hiking and paved trails, benches, picnic tables, pavilion, ponds, and streams. Copley Township's economy is based on several shopping areas, plants, and agricultural businesses. The rest of the township is dotted with picturesque farms and subdivisions. The [Akron Fossils and Science Center](#) is also located here.

FAIRLAWN

[Fairlawn](#) -This fair city, in [Summit County](#) is home to 7,307 people. Fairlawn is a planned bedroom community. Through careful zoning, they've balanced green space and business space. KENT

[Kent](#) City is in [Portage County](#). There are 27,906 people residing in the city, making it the county's largest city. Kent is home to the main campus of [Kent State University](#) which is the area's major institution of post-secondary education and is the city and county's largest employer. KSU is also home to the [Fashion Museum](#). Elementary and secondary schooling is mainly provided by the [Kent City School District](#) with the small portion of the city south of SR 261 being served by the neighboring [Field Local School District](#). Kent became known as the "[Tree City](#)" when, in the late 1800s, John Davey, an expert horticulturalist, planted hundreds of trees throughout the city.

LAKEMORE

[Lakemore](#) - village in [Summit County](#) has an estimated population of 2,561 people residing in the village. Lakemore is part of neighboring [Springfield Local School District](#). Lakemore boasts the Lakemore Plaza Shopping Center, which has recently multi-million dollar renovation, [Lakemore Community Baptist Church](#), [Lakemore United Methodist Church](#), [Lakemore Recreation Park](#) and Waterworks Park. Lakemore is known as "the progressive village."

MOGADORE

[Mogadore](#) is a village in [Portage](#) and [Summit](#) counties with a population of 3,893 people residing there. [Mogadore Local Schools](#) recently won the 2010 State Football Final Four Division VI. This small village boasts the [Mogadore United Methodist Church](#) and it's CHRISTMAS IN THE VILLAGE ANNUAL CELEBRATION at the Mogadore Community Center. [Mogadore Historical Society's](#) historic landmarks include the [Norfolk and Western Railroad Depot](#) and the [Mills-Kreiner House](#). [West's Mogadore Country Club and Golf Course](#) is an 18 hole course.

MUNROE FALLS

[Munroe Falls](#) is located in the northeast portion of [Summit County](#) with a population of 5,314 people residing in the city. It is a small residential community with a rate of growth slow enough to preserve its rich history and quick enough to stay on course through the next century. The city shares a school system with neighboring [Stow](#), [Stow Munroe Falls City School District](#). [Ballet Theater of Ohio](#) makes it's home here. [Munroe Falls Park](#) offers water sports, picnic area, playground, ball fields, fishing, sledding & cross-country-skiing.

NORTON

[Norton](#) is located in both [Summit](#) and [Wayne](#) counties. 11,523 people reside in the city. One of the largest attended events in Norton is the [annual Cider Festival](#) in late September. The City of Norton has a [Community Center and beautiful Public Parks](#) as well as [Silver Creek Metro Park](#) and [Loyal Oak Lake Park](#) for swimming, picnicking, camping, playing and golf. Norton also supports a summer recreation program that provides children with a wide assortment of activities including youth sports of [baseball](#), football / cheerleading, and [soccer](#). For more information on all of Norton's youth sports go to [Nortonyouthsports.com](#). The [Norton City School System](#) enjoys a highly-rated academic report, as well as extremely supportive sport and band parental groups. Norton is popular not only for its quiet rural quality of life but for its easy accessibility to major cities. The [Winery at Wolf Creek](#) is a great place to relax and enjoy local wines.

PENINSULA

[Peninsula](#) village in [Summit County](#) is home to 602 people residing in the village. PORTAGE LAKES (Coventry Township)

[Portage Lakes \(Coventry Township\)](#) - Located in [Summit](#) County, [Coventry Township's](#) population is 10,900 residents. This community is surrounded by the lakes making up [Portage Lakes State Park](#). The [Coventry Clock Tower](#) serves as a historic landmark in the heart of the [Portage Lakes](#). RAVENNA

[Ravenna](#) is the county seat of [Portage County](#). Known as "Main Street, USA" because of its wonderful blend of 1800s architecture, century homes, modern housing and industry. Ravenna is home to [Robinson Memorial Hospital](#) which is consistently rated as one of the top 99 places to work in Northeast Ohio. Quality instruction, focused professional development, outstanding staff, supportive parents, and great students all contribute to the quest of "Excellence!" within the [Ravenna City School System](#). Higher education within the city is provided by [Fortis Business College](#) and [Maplewood Career Center](#). Ravenna has three main [parks](#), Havre's Woods Park, The John Tontimonia City Park and the Children's Park offers activities for all ages. For golf fans, Ravenna is home to [Windmill Lakes Golf Club](#). Hikers and bikers will find the [Portage Hike and Bike Trail](#) running right through the heart of Ravenna.

RICHFIELD

[Richfield](#) is a [village](#) and [township](#) in [Summit County](#). The village's population is 3,286 people and the township is home to 2024 people. Richfield's strategic location (directly between Cleveland and Akron) makes life comfortable and convenient for its residents. [Revere Local School District](#) serves Richfield residents. There are 228 acres dedicated to a public park and recreation area. The park has the East Branch of the Rocky River running through it and offers a diversity of ecosystems. Team sports such as baseball, softball, and soccer utilize the playing fields. The park also has picnic areas, hiking and seasonal sled-riding and cross country skiing. Another natural bonus is the [Cuyahoga Valley National Park](#) on Richfield's eastern border. This large area has [ski slopes](#), running areas, wildlife preserves and picnic areas. [Richfield Historical Society](#) ensures the future by preserving the past. Richfield is a unique community with a distinct small-town flavor.

ROOTSTOWN

[Rootstown](#), located in [Portage County](#), has a population of 7,212. The park was sold in 1917 and subdivided for residential building.

[Stow Munroe Falls City School District](#). The City of [Stow](#) is a dynamic community which has experienced steady growth in the last decade. The City has long recognized the benefits of a diverse tax base and a balance between residential, commercial, and industrial development. [Stow](#) is committed to providing an environment where citizens may safely raise their children and businesses can thrive. Stow is proud of its 11 [Neighborhood and Community Parks and Playgrounds](#), [Astronomy Program](#), the 7.5 acre dog park, [Bow Wow Beach](#) and it's municipally-owned [Silver Springs Campground](#). SUFFIELD

[Suffield Township](#) is located in [Portage County](#). With a population of 6383, they are a close-knit community. Suffield shares its school system with neighboring Brimfield to make [Field Local School District](#).

TALLMADGE

[Tallmadge](#) is a city in [Summit](#) and [Portage Counties](#). 16,390 people residing in the city. The [Tallmadge City Schools](#) provide primary and secondary education for the 2,700 public school students within Tallmadge. At the center of the town is the Historic [Tallmadge Church](#) (built in 1825), recognized as a historic place by the [Ohio Historical Society](#). A circle surrounds the church and a small park, the Tallmadge Circle Park. The Circle Park is also home to [Tallmadge's Old Town Hall](#) (established 1859), which houses a museum. [The Tallmadge Recreation Center](#) offers basketball, volleyball, tennis, an indoor Astroturf field used for football, soccer and band practice. Walking/jogging track, batting cages, exercise and game rooms, Nautilus and free weight exercise area, and playground. Tallmadge offers an abundance of activities for both young and old. Tallmadge is also home to the [Summit County Fairgrounds](#).

WADSWORTH

[Wadsworth](#) is located in [Medina County](#). The population of Wadsworth is 20,810. The City of Wadsworth offers the quaintness of a small town, coupled with the sophistication of a community that is progressive. Residents' activities center around the strong [Wadsworth City Schools](#), which are rated '[Excellent with Distinction](#)' in the State for the past eight years. [The historic downtown](#) is a vibrant part of the City, with numerous businesses.
